Open Doors 65 is a nonprofit 501 (c) (3) organization. They provide Christian based hope and help to those in need, serving people of all ages and backgrounds. They do their best to be a blessing to everyone who comes thru the doors. Their mission statement is:

To reach people for Jesus by providing for physical and spiritual needs in a Christ-honoring way.

Open Doors 65 is a free thrift store, they offer clothing, and housewares, friendship and encouragement, prayer, Bibles and information about local churches. They offer coffee and conversation, perhaps just a place to escape the cold for a while. As a Christian organization they use the message of Christs forgiveness and love to help serve the people.

They accept donations of volunteers, clothing and housewares as well as financial assistance. They have rental and utility expenses. They serve an average of 365 – 500 guests per month, that is over 200 households per month and approximately 35% homeless. They typically distribute 2500 to 3000 items of clothing and housewares each month. If you are ever in the area please stop in learn more about Open Doors 65.

Dr. Michael L. Brown 7:00 PM Sunday, November 12th

Dr. Michael L. Brown is the founder and president of FIRE School of Ministry in Concord, North Carolina and is a Director of the Coalition of Conscience. He is the host of the daily, national talk radio show, "The Line of Fire" and the host of the apologetics TV show, "Answering Your Toughest Questions," which airs on the NRB TV network. Dr. Brown became a believer in Jesus in 1971 as a sixteen year-old, heroin-shooting, LSD-using Jewish rock drummer. Since then, he has preached throughout the U.S.A. and around the world, bringing a message of repentance, revival, reformation, and cultural revolution. He has debated Jewish rabbis, agnostic professors and political activists on the radio, TV and college campuses. Dr. Brown holds a Ph.D. in Near Eastern Languages & Literatures from New York University and has served as an adjunct and/or visiting professor at a number of Christian seminaries and universities. As a published author on a variety of topics, Dr. Brown is widely considered to be the world's foremost Messianic Jewish apologist. He and his wife Nancy, who is also a Jewish believer in Jesus, have been married since 1976. They have two daughters and four grandchildren.
