PROJECT 1:17

Mission of the Month for November

Project 1:17 (P117) is a local ministry focused on serving and advocating for orphans locally and internationally. Locally by recruiting foster and adoptive families and then providing support and resources through the process and going forward. Internationally, through partnering with and serving alongside brothers and sisters in Christ devoted to orphan care and prevention in Ethiopia.

Orphan prevention takes many forms and has become even more vital in Ethiopia with international adoption ending. Our partner, Covenant Development has engaged in orphan prevention through providing sponsorships which transition into training and startup funds to allow the family to become self-sufficient. The majority of the families in the sponsorships are single mom led families or grandparents raising grandchildren for various reasons and without help, many of these children could be abandoned or worse, due to poverty limiting food and shelter.

Project 1:17 has partnered with Covenant in these sponsorships and specifically in providing funds to start up small businesses that can provide self-sufficiency. In the past 5 years, 53 families have or are in the middle of transitioning to self-sufficiency by working in a variety of vocations including; farming, livestock, weaving, "barber" shop, delivery service, spice and retail shops.

Almost all of these sponsored families are located in areas where Covenant has planted churches. They are up to 12 church starts and continue to pray for God's guidance on where next. P117 has had the privilege of spending time in prayer, fellowship and sharing the word with the local church leaders and their congregations, many of which are located in very rural areas.
