Conversations throughout the day and in the cars during traveling were really good and friendships were definitely deepened that day! One couple that came with for the ski trip have since invited us (Sunny and Katie) to their house several times. They came to the United States one year ago and are now studying and working in Fargo. Due to wars and being refugees in other countries, they had been denied access to education for most of their childhood. The husband taught himself how to read and write when he was 15 years old. He is hungry to learn and they are desperate to get rich because they feel that will give them security and happiness in life. They are searching for peace, truth, and meaning in life. Please pray that their eyes will be opened to their spiritual needs and that God will heal the scars from their past. Recently more friendship families have been connected with students and students are giving us excited updates about what they have done with their friendship families! The past couple of months we have also been seeing many students have an eagerness for friendship beyond Friday nights at the Pink House and other followers of Jesus have also noticed an increased openness to spiritual conversations!
