First African UMC Outreach of the Month for June

The First African United Methodist Church (FAUMC, initially called the International Congregation was founded in April, 2011 to be considered as a “Second Worship Service”. The vision was “Making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the World,” by reaching out to New Americans within the Fargo/Moorhead community.

The Congregation’s number started at 5 at the first service and later increased to 28 within few months. The congregation was accepted by the Dakota Conference as a “New Church Start” July 2015, and Pastor Abednego B. Thomas, Sr. was appointed by the Bishop through the Dakotas Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church as the pastor of the now named First African United Methodist. FAUC Methodist Church now has a membership of up to 252 with an average Sunday worship of 98. We have a unique worship service in English, with various ministries including our scholarship program, which help low income, mostly single mothers to attend and earn CNA license to improve their incomes. We partner with Calvary UMC and other community projects that benefits our larger community.

We have a team of outreach members that have been visiting homeless shelters within the Fargo/Moorhead area. Our plan is to get the needed clothing and food items for individuals in those shelters, build a relationship, and offer them Jesus.
