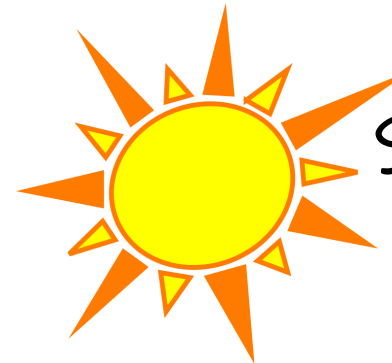

We're coming home...

Yes, you read that correctly. In our last update we were moving from China to Thailand, and now we're moving from Thailand to the US.

We went to Thailand with the expectation that while there, we would receive clear direction from the Lord as to what the next step was and where our family would be living for the foreseeable future. We were confident that we would hear a location, a physical place that we would soon be calling "home." Instead, the Lord showed us what is on His heart for us, as a family, in this new season we're entering. And so while we still are waiting on Him to lead us to the next place we will settle at, in the meantime, we are walking with Him on this journey that is bringing us back to the US for at least the next 6 months.

So while the decision of "where" still lies before us (and is continually on our minds), we are learning to walk in trust and rest without having all the details, knowing that Jesus cares so deeply for our hearts. He cares enough to take us across the sea to "rest a while." (Mark 6:31-32).

Our time in Thailand was very fruitful. We were able to meet with a counselor and do some debriefing, which was especially helpful for our kids to express what they're feeling. We also spent time almost daily with the team from the YWAM Call2all base, joining in prayer and worship sets, leading a few prayer initiatives, and going deep in community (that's one of our options for where we'll land in the future).

Please pray for our family as we travel 30+ hours with 4 kids and nearly all our possessions (in 9 suitcases!). Pray for us as we settle in and adjust to new rhythms in a land that is going to be so familiar...and yet so foreign.

We love you and love being on this journey together to exalt Jesus in the earth!

In the Face of Fear. . . What Drives You? Daniel 1:8-16; 3:13-18; 6:1-28

- I. Be driven by your DESIRE to please God. (1:8-16)
When the desire for God is tested:
Test Number 1: Eating of royal food and drinking wine
 - A. Choose not to COMPROMISE your FAITH, but stand firm for God. (1:8-16)Test Number 2: Worshipping idols
 - B. Choose not to bring SHAME to God, but only bring praise and glory. (3:13-18)Test Number 3: Praying to idols
 - C. Choose not to give ALLEGIANCE/LOYALTY to anyone but God. (6:6-9)
- II. Be driven by Your DETERMINATION to please God. (6:1-4)
 - A. Choose to be a man of excellence. (v.3)
 - B. Choose to be a man of example. (v.4)
- III. Be driven by your DEVOTION to please God. (vv. 10-28)
 - A. Choose to be PERSISTENT in your prayer/quiet time. (v.10)
 - B. Choose to be DEPENDENT on God, and God alone. (vv.16-23)
 - C. Choose to be MISSION-MINDED wherever God places you. (vv.24-28)
