TATISTIC

- The primary victims of lying are (1) parents 86%, (2) friends 75%, (3) siblings 73%, and (4) spouses 69%. An average person lies 1-2 times a day.
- 60% of people lie at least once in a 10-minute conversation.

STATISTIC

- 81% of people lie about their height, weight or age online.
- 40% of people lie on their resumes.
- 90% of people lie on their online dating profiles

TATISTIC

- 50% of teenagers admit to lying to their parents about their whereabouts.
- Lying on a phone call during voice chat is 70% more likely to feature lies than a face-to-face chat.
- Of all liars, 70% of them claim to be willing to do it again.

TATISTIC

Politicians lie on average <u>once every</u> <u>five minutes</u> during a debate.



Lying is a common human behavior, with 60% of people admitting to telling the most common lie: "I'm fine."


