





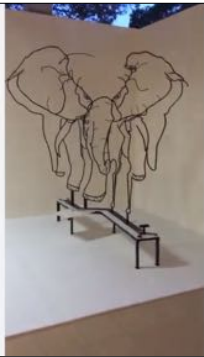
A BIG ASK (grammarist.com):

When we change the way we look at things, the things we look at change.

Be curious about what God is up to (Luke 1:29)

Luke 1:29 Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be.

Ask God questions (Luke 1:34)

Luke 1:34 "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"

Connect with the people who are for you, *cause not everyone is* (Luke 1:41-42).

Luke 1:41-42 When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. In a loud voice she exclaimed: "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear!"
