anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.	
Forgiveness is part of Jesus' model of prayer. Matthew 6:12 (excerpt from the Lord's prayer) - And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
