



Who is Jesus?


CHRISTOLOGY: The study of the person and work of Jesus Christ.


¹³—children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Depending on the scholar, many believed that Jesus fulfilled as many as 300+ prophecies.

Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled: Virgin Birth

Prophecy: "Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14)

Fulfillment: Matthew 1:23

Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled: Born in Bethlehem

Prophecy: "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times." (Micah 5:2)

Fulfillment: Matthew 2:5-6

Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled: Flight to Egypt

Prophecy: "When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt, I called my son." (Hosea 11:1)

Fulfillment: **Matthew 2:14-15**

Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled: Preceded by a Messenger

Prophecy: "A voice of one calling: 'In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.'" (Isaiah 40:3)

Fulfillment: **Matthew 3:1-3**

**Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled:
Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem**

Prophecy: "Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey." (Zechariah 9:9)

Fulfillment: **Matthew 21:4-5**

Prophecies Jesus Fulfilled: Crucifixion

Prophecy: "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds, we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5)



Why do we need a Savior? Does mankind need saving?




SOTERIOLOGY: The study of salvation *(in faith or religions)*



¹²Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned—



¹³To be sure, sin was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not charged against anyone's account where there is no law.


This verse answers the question of what happens to people who have never heard the Gospel.




¹⁵But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many!


¹⁶Nor can the gift of God be compared with the result of one man's sin: The judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation, but the gift followed many trespasses and brought justification.


¹⁷For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ!


¹⁸Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people.




¹⁹For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

What is the Gospel of Jesus Christ?



Why does God want his followers to preach the Gospel (Good news)?




"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes..."
