On behalf of the literacy school in the Philippines, once again we are very grateful to the Lord for giving you as our partner in the ministry in sharing His great love to my people back home through illiteracy. This reminds me of the verse in 1 Samuel 12:24 that says, “But be sure to fear the Lord and serve Him FAITHFULLY with all your heart; consider what great things He has done for you.” This is one of the reasons why we keep on serving Him because of the great things He has done for us through Calvary ministry. Many souls are being touched and blessed and you all become God’s feet and hands in fulfilling the mission that He has impressed in our hearts in reaching out people through basic education.

The school is doing great! We have bought some chairs for the school (since some are already broken), we bought a laptop computer and other necessary school supplies. We have been so blessed by the faithfulness of the members of the church for their dedication in helping us through discipleship and encouraging the students to have that intimate relationship with the Lord. We are still working on other necessary improvements for the school, especially the bathroom. We are hoping to be finished with that as soon as the budget permits. As of now, we are praying for other forms of resources, like books, encyclopedias or set of computer units, since the electricity is already installed for research purposes and printing needs for the teacher and volunteers. We still do devotionals during the class session, fellowship and worship. We are so happy to see that the students are not only learning to read and write, but also learning who Jesus is in their lives. Please continue to pray with us as we continue to serve our living God through the school. Thank you so much for your partnership and the service rendered for the Lord! May God bless us all.
