From Finland to Fargo: God is Connecting People

This fall an American girl sat down at the Pink House and struck up a conversation with a Chinese man, “Hey, you look familiar, do I know you?” He hesitated before replying: “You also look familiar but...I only arrived in Fargo a few days ago.” They talked for several minutes and discovered that several years ago they had both attended the same university in FINLAND!! They had many mutual friends and had a great conversation catching up on mutual friends from Finland. Before leaving for the evening the man agreed when someone commented “Wow, it seems like God wanted your paths to cross again!” From Finland to Fargo, God connects paths for a reason. This is just one of many God connections this fall. In recent weeks we have also seen a conversation in a restaurant lead to almost a dozen Arab students joining us and an early Thanksgiving dinner with a dozen Indians from Sunny’s home state! We are excited to see where God will bring these new friendships!
